



HEALTH SERVICES COURSE

Skills for Work and Study - Health Services is an exciting new training program starting 21/5/2021.

The course is 10 weeks long, 2 days a week on Mondays and Fridays from 9:30AM to 3:00PM, commencing from 21/5/21 to 9/8/21.

The course includes:

- Specialist speakers
- Work place visits and excursions
- Classroom and online activities

The course outline:

- An introduction to the health sector and entry level jobs and responsibilities
- Goal setting and learning/employment pathways in health services
- Hygiene and infection control
- Customer service and communication skills
- Conduct, duty of care and confidentiality requirements in healthcare
- Workplace Health and Safety in healthcare

Improve your employability skills, reading, writing and digital literacy for employment in hospitals, nursing homes, community health centres, and for higher studies in health.
