

## Responding to Health Warnings Policy

#### Purpose

This Policy outlines the NMLL's approach to inform staff, students and visitor of official health warnings, including Heat Alerts.

#### Scope

This Policy applies to NMLL staff, students and visitors to NMLL, including course applicants, those involved in on-site activities and contractors.

### Background

Experts advise that extreme weather will be more frequent. These events may affect peoples' health. NMLL is committed to providing a safe working environment for staff and a safe environment for students and visitors. Consequently NMLL will be proactively receive disseminate and act on health alerts and advice.

### Policy

- NMLL will at all times be registered to receive official health warning from the Commonwealth Chief Medical Officer and Victoria's Chief Medical Officer.
- NMLL will determine if the advice is appropriate to those engaged with NMLL or at NMLL premises.
- Where the advice applies to those engaged at NMLL or at NMLL premises the advice will be transmitted to those affected at the earliest convenience.
- Information will be conveyed in the most appropriate manner for each audience.
- Required actions will be implemented and monitored until such time as the health warning is rescinded.
